1. **Entry deadline: Saturday, May 15, 2010.** Entries must be postmarked by this date. *Late entries will not be considered for judging.*
2. Student **must be enrolled in a world language** during the 2009/2010 academic year. The student's teacher **must be a current member of IFLTA.**
3. All entries must be **8 1/2" X 11"** in size and prepared on a **white background.** **Student's name and school must not appear on the design.** Students are encouraged to use the back of the Entry Form to create their design to ensure proper identification by IFLTA. Otherwise, have students write their name in pencil on the back of their design and paperclip student entry forms to the artwork to avoid damage.
4. Only Original artwork may be submitted. **No copyrighted figures or photocopied designs** may be used.
5. **COLOR ENTRIES ARE ALLOWED!** Student's may create black and white entries, but are not limited to those colors.
6. **BE CREATIVE**, as the theme is only limited to the scope of imagination. Students are strongly encouraged to communicate and integrate their foreign language skills in accordance with Indiana state foreign language standards into their poster design (see scoring rubric at www.iflta.org/ for more details). Be sure that any message appearing on the poster is clear and any text directly relates to the design or picture contained on the poster.
7. Entries are judged in **three developmentally-appropriate categories** – Elementary (K-5), Middle School (6-8), and High School (9-12). Entries should have a clear, cohesive message as it pertains to the theme. A copy of the judge's scoring rubric may be found at www.iflta.org/. Judges rubric scores will be combined and tallied to determine winners in each of the three categories. **Prizes will be awarded in each category** and are listed below:

1st prize:	\$75
2nd prize:	\$50
3rd prize:	\$35

One **grand prize winner** will be selected. That student **will receive an additional \$25 and a framed copy** of the winning design.

SCHOOL LIMIT: Only five entries per school may be submitted. Please confer with other world language instructors in your school to select the five entries. In the case where more than five entries are received from the same school, only the first five entries will be considered; all others will not be considered for judging.

8. All entries become the property of IFLTA.
9. Winning entries will be on display at the 2010 IFLTA Conference. **Copies of winning entries are available for reprint in 3" x 5" postcard format.** Order forms may be downloaded by visiting www.iflta.org/ or by visiting the IFLTA poster contest table at the 2010 IFLTA Conference.
